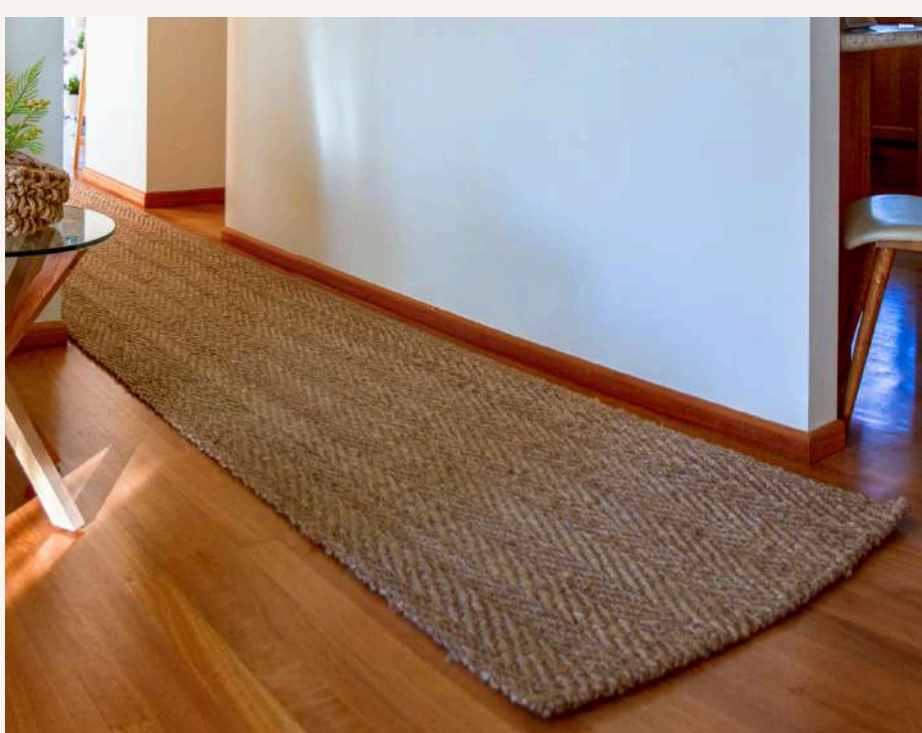

Care and Maintenance

- Vacuum regularly using suction only.
- Blot spills immediately with a clean, dry cloth.
- Keep dry at all times and avoid excessive moisture.
- Rotate periodically for even wear.
- Use a rug pad for added protection and stability.
- Professional dry cleaning is recommended for deep cleaning.

Natural Fibre Characteristics

As a natural fibre, jute may experience some shedding, sprouting, and loose ends, especially when new. This is a normal characteristic of handcrafted jute rugs. Do not pull loose fibres, as this may damage the weave; simply trim them with sharp scissors or gently tuck them back into the rug.
